The Mill Rythe Autumn Darts Festival celebrated its 25<sup>th</sup> - 13th November and once again proved to be a thoroughly enjoyable weekend for those in attendance, both on and off the oche. The recently refurbished site was full to capacity and provided an ideal backdrop to two days of hard fought competition on the floor, all of which culminated in the stage finals on Sunday afternoon. In this unique event where the Ladies Prize monies are equal to the Men's and the entry fees are only £3.00 per player per event there were some terrific performances and the sportsmanlike manner in which the events were contested was a credit to all that took part

The Mixed Triples Final saw an all Hampshire contest, with the trio of Gary Stafford, Mike Gillet and Leigh-Ann Findlay beating Hampshire team-mates, Lee Ward, Nillson Pritchard & Samantha Pike 3-1. In the Ladies Pairs final, Hampshire duo Sue Lowther and Gemma Hayter lost out 3-1 to Oxfordshire's Deta Hedman and London's Tammy Mackenzie.

In the Men's Pairs final, it was the experienced pairing of Paul Hogan & Paul Gibbs who took the title, beating Sussex duo Mark Davis & Sid Perkins 3-1.

The Youth under 18 Final, sponsored this year by Simon Whitlock, proved to be an absolute cracker. Despite hitting a 25.98 average, Hampshire's Thomas Chant lost out 3-0 to Ryan Sullivan from Sussex. Ryan hit a 26.47 average in an exciting match that kept the large crowd thoroughly entertained and left no one in any doubt that the future of darts is in very safe and capable hands

In the Under 14's event, held on the Saturday, David Monaghan of Hampshire beat Dorset's Daniel Perry.

Gemma Hayter another young and very talented player put up a tremendous fight against Deta Hedman in the Ladies Singles final, but Deta played a faultless game to win 4-0. Gemma played very well, hitting a 20.63 average, but Deta was at her determined best and won the game with an excellent 26.72 average.

The last match of the weekend was a close fought Men's Singles Final between Jamie Robinson from Essex and John Jenkinson from Sussex. Jamie was 4-2 up in the best of 9 final, having hit finishes of 141 and 115. Unfortunately, his finishing deserted him in his efforts to take one more leg and John fought back to win the next 3 legs and take the title 5-4.
